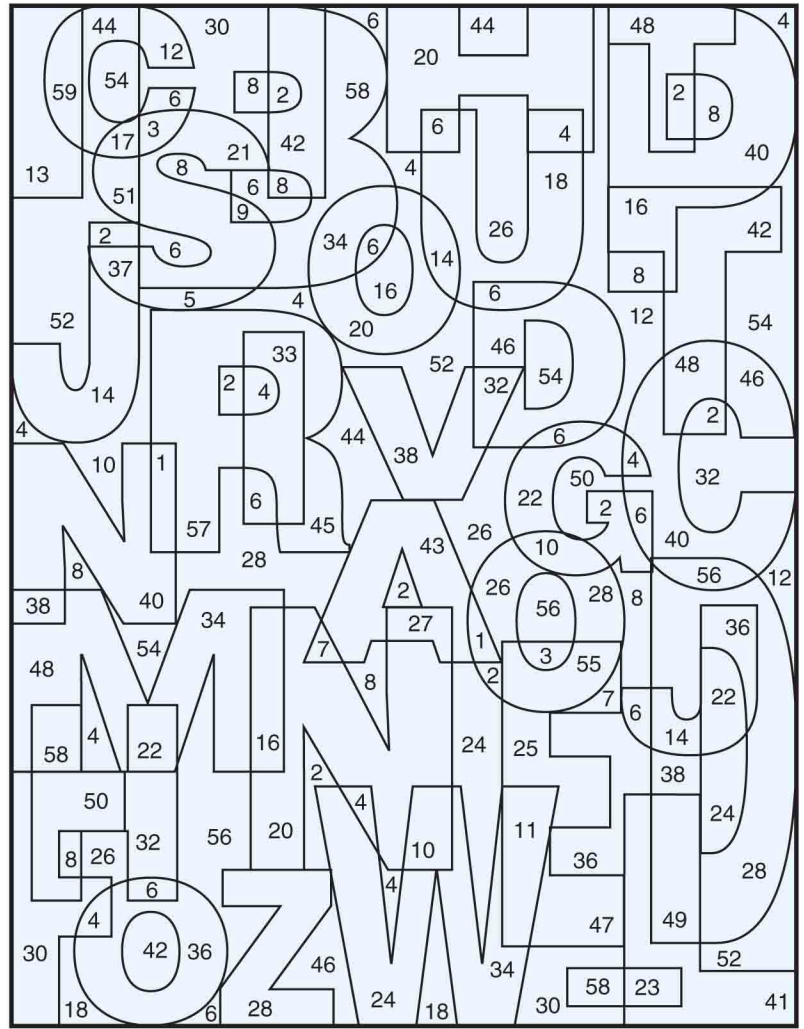


The psalm says

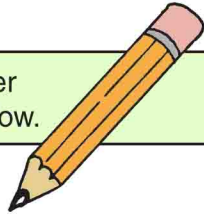

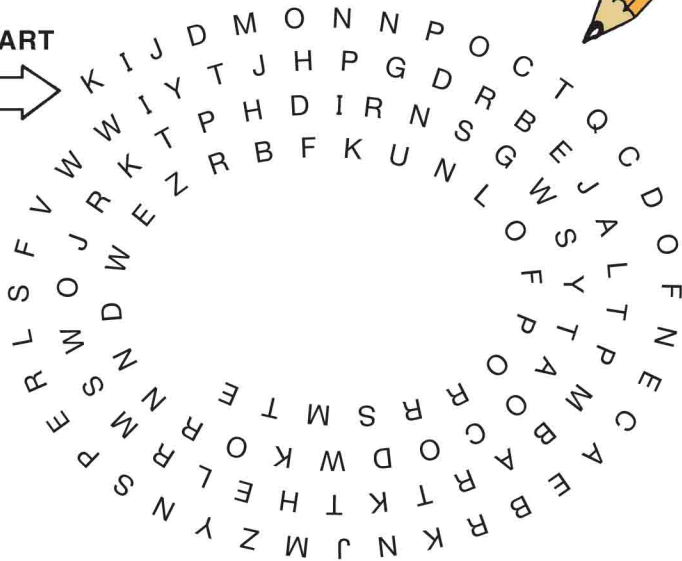
