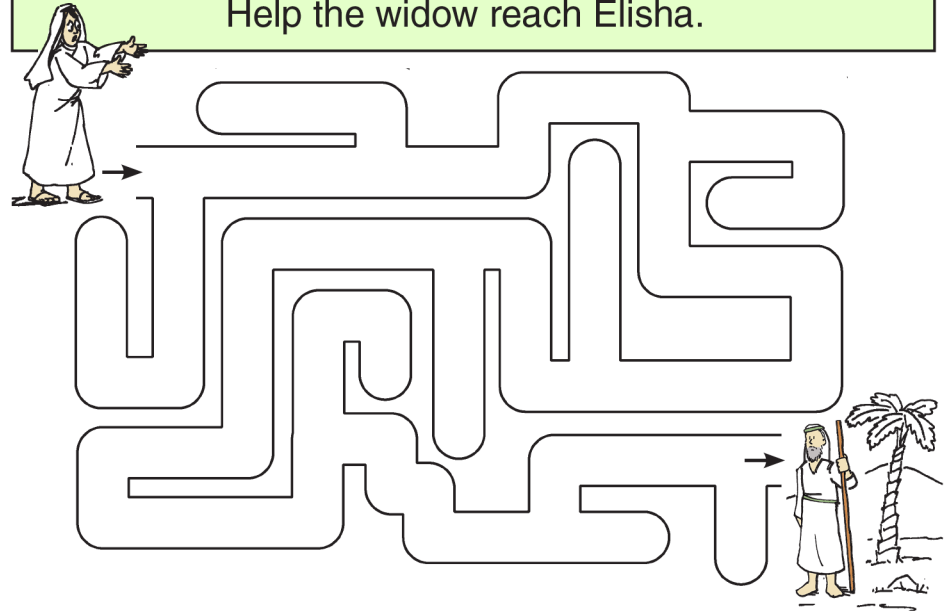
The Widow's Olive Oil

She told Elisha she owed money to someone but had no way to repay them.



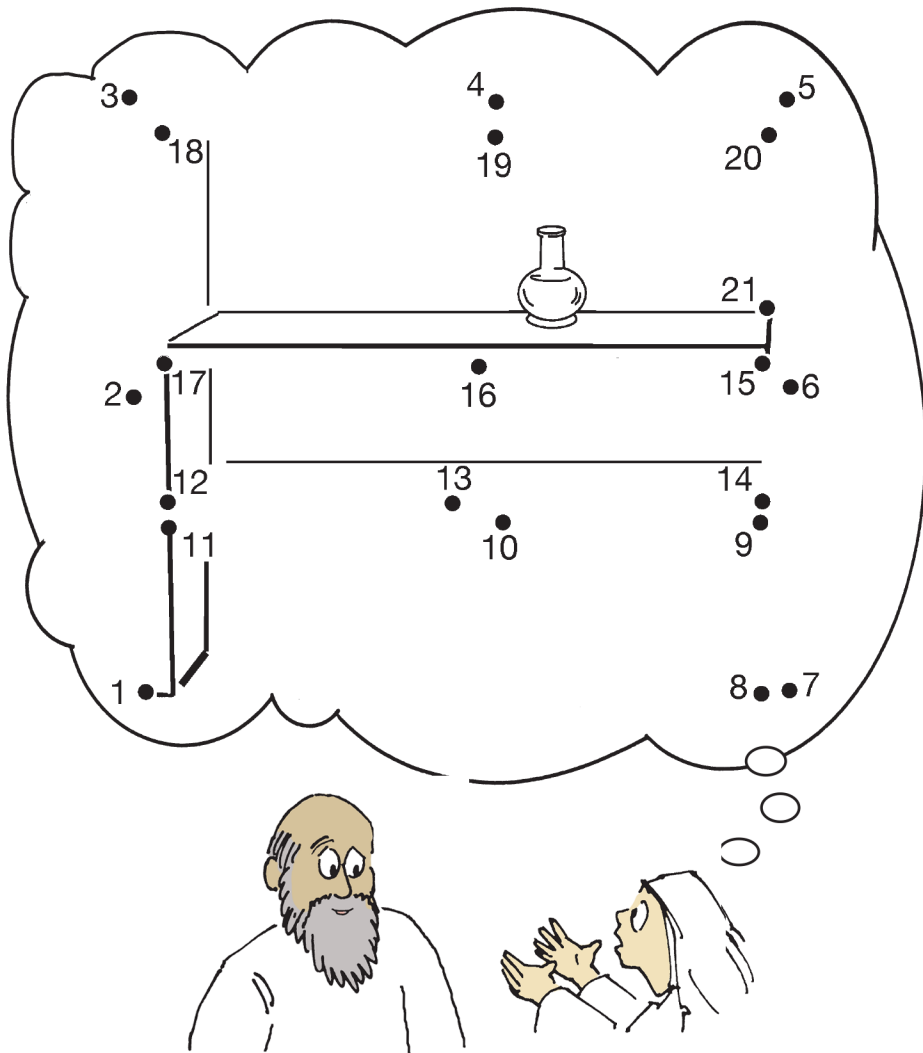
